Small Group Questions for "A New LIFE".

- 1. **In Romans 6:1-4**, Paul asks if we should continue in sin so that grace may abound. What does it mean to be "dead to sin but alive to God"? How does baptism symbolize this reality?
 - o Additional scripture: Colossians 2:12-14, Galatians 2:20
- 2. **Romans 6:11-14** calls us to "consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus." What practical steps can we take to stop presenting ourselves as instruments of sin and instead present ourselves to God as instruments of righteousness?
 - Additional scripture: Ephesians 4:22-24, 1 Peter 2:24
- 3. **In Romans 6:16-18**, Paul uses the imagery of slavery. How does being "slaves to righteousness" actually lead to true freedom? What does this freedom look like in your daily life?
 - o Additional scripture: John 8:31-36, Galatians 5:1, 13-14
- 4. **Romans 6:22-23** contrasts the wages of sin with the free gift of God. Why does Paul describe eternal life as a "free gift" rather than something earned? How does this shape our understanding of salvation?
 - Additional scripture: Ephesians 2:8-10, Titus 3:4-7
- 5. Throughout Romans 6, Paul emphasizes that believers have died with Christ and are raised to new life. What areas of your life still need to experience this transformation? How can we help each other live out this new identity?
 - o Additional scripture: 2 Corinthians 5:17, Philippians 3:8-11
