CITY GROUP REFLECTION QUESTIONS

1. In what ways do you feel cultural pressure right now? How does remembering that your identity was settled by God before culture ever had a vote change how you respond?

3. What would it look like to live noticeably distinct — not combative or self-righteous — but genuinely transformed in your current environment (work, school, neighborhood)?
4. Peter says we've been born again into a *living hope* through the resurrection. What are some "dead hopes" people commonly rely on today?
5. Verse 5 says we are being guarded by God's power. Do you tend to live like everything depends on you? Where might you need to rest more in God's protection?
6. If you truly believed this week that you are chosen, sanctified, hopeful, inheriting something eternal, and guarded by God — what would change in how you move through your life and relationships?
