## DAILY DEVOTIONALS

**Monday — El Hannun: The Gracious God** *Read: John 8:1–11* Jesus was the only one who could have thrown a stone. He chose mercy — and then said "go and sin no more."

Is there something you're still carrying as if Jesus hasn't already seen it and chosen you anyway? Which do you lean into more — the grace, or the call to change?

**Tuesday — El Elyon: God Most High** *Read: Matthew 8:28–34* The demons didn't fight Jesus. They begged. There was no contest.

What has authority over your life right now — a fear, a habit, a pattern you can't break? Do you actually live like Jesus has more power over it than it does?

**Wednesday — Emmanuel: God With Us** *Read: Matthew 8:5–13* The centurion just said "say the word." He believed Jesus was near and that it was enough.

Is "God is with me" something you believe, or something you actually live? Where's the gap?

**Thursday — Elohim: The Creator God** *Read: Mark 4:35–41* Jesus commanded the storm the way you'd tell a dog to sit. He wasn't asking — He was in charge.

What's your current storm? Have you actually brought it to Jesus, or are you just managing it on your own?

**Friday — Yeshua: YHWH Saves** *Read: Luke 19:1–10* Jesus didn't wait for Zacchaeus to clean up. He stopped under the tree and called him by name.

Is there an area where you're still up in the tree, holding back from Jesus? What would it look like to come down today?
