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Weekly Reflection Questions

- 1. Read: Acts 1:12–14** When life gets uncertain, is your instinct to pull away from community or move toward it? The disciples gathered — they didn't scatter. What makes gathering with other believers hard for you right now, and what would it take to change that?
- 2. Read: Acts 1:15–17** Peter named the Judas situation directly in front of 120 people. Is there something in your own story — a failure, a loss, a betrayal — you've been avoiding naming? What would honest processing look like instead of pretending it didn't happen?
- 3. Read: Acts 1:17–19** The sermon said: when someone disqualifies themselves from leadership, they don't disqualify the work they did. Have you ever pulled back from something God was building because of someone else's failure — or your own? What would it look like to let God keep building through it?
- 4. Read: 1 Timothy 3:1–2** Paul says leadership is built on character, not talent. Where are you currently investing more in your skills than your character? What's one area where you know character work still needs to happen in you?
- 5. Read: 1 Timothy 3:6** Paul warns that putting someone into leadership too soon sets them up for pride and a fall. Have you ever been placed in a role before you were ready — or placed someone else in one? What did that cost, and what does wise, patient preparation look like?
- 6. Read: Acts 1:24** The disciples prayed "Lord, you know everyone's heart" before making a major decision about leadership. How much does prayer actually shape your big decisions — especially ones involving people? What would it look like to choose people more from your knees than from your instincts?
7. This week the message opened with this: before there was a strategy, there was dependency. Where are you most tempted right now to run on your own strength instead of genuine dependence on God? What would one specific act of surrender look like this week?
