CITY GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Think of something you used to see as an obligation but eventually started to actually enjoy. What changed? How does that compare to the idea of shifting from "I have to" to "I get to" when it comes to following Jesus?
2. The early church devoted themselves to the Word and prayer — not out of duty, but because they couldn't get enough of it. Where are you at with that right now? Does time with God feel more like a chore or a gift lately, and why do you think that is?
3. This passage describes a church so connected that people sold what they had so nobody around them would go without. Who's someone in your life you could hold your resources a little more open-handed toward this week?
4. "Sincere" in this passage paints a picture of a heart with no hidden agenda — nothing false, nothing to trip over. Is there an area of your life right now where you're not being fully honest with God, or with the people close to you? You don't have to share details, just where you're at.
5. The gathering in this story didn't stay in one room — it started at the temple and spilled into homes, meals, and everyday life. Where do you see your faith spilling over into the ordinary parts of your week, and where does it feel more boxed in?
6. God did the growing in this church — the believers just stayed faithful to show up and love people. Is there someone specific you sense God putting on your heart to be a witness to this week? What's one honest, low-pressure way you could take a step toward them?
